Online applications are invited for admissions into 6th class & 7th, 8th & 9th classes in (23) EMR Schools of Telangana State for the Academic Year 2023-24. The eligibility criteria and procedure of admission is furnished below.

1. Eligibility:

A. Admission eligibility for 6th Class & for Back log vacancies of 7th, 8th & 9th Classes:

The Minimum and maximum age limit (as on 31st March of the year in which admission is sought in EMR Schools in various classes is given below: (Child born on 1st April should also be considered)

- i. The maximum age limit can be relaxed by two years in case of Differently abled children by the State / Societies.
- ii. Parental Income for the financial year 2023-24 should not exceed Rupees Two Lakh (2 lakh) per annum for urban and 1.5 lakh for rural or as per the Government guidelines at the time of admission.
- iii. Candidates should have qualified class V/ VI/ VII/VIII in the Academic session 2022-23 or 2021-22 from a Govt / Govt. aided / Govt recognized school / CBSE Affiliated School are eligible for VI/ VII/VIII/IX respectively.
- iv. Candidate should not be rusticated from any of the schools.
- v. The Candidate shall be allotted admission in any of the EMRS running across the state as per the Merit list prepared on the basis of selection Test.

- vi. A screening test will be conducted for admission into VI & Back log admissions for VII, VIII & IX classes and allotment of seats will be done through online merit basis only.
- vii. All the seats will be filled as per the state merit and candidate option.
- viii. All the applied candidates have to give all the options to allot the seat as per the merit.

a. Reservation in Admission for 6th class:

NOTE: 1. It includes citizens victims of LWE and Police/ Paramilitary/ Armed Forces Persons who lost their lives fighting LWE.

2. 5% i.e 3 seats out of 60 are reserved for Differently abled children. These seats shall be carved out @ 2 seats from ST and 1 seat from others.

Note:

- 1.** The Children of staff of EMRSs/ EMDBSs/ CoE/Doctors/ Paramedical Staff of Government Hospital serving in the same block shall be given admission over and above the prescribed strength of 30 students per section per class.
- 2.** This facility shall be extended to only eldest two surviving children.

3. The Principal is authorized to admit the children of staff in the respective EMRSs/EMDBSs//CES Where the parent is working and Doctors/ paramedical Staff of Government Hospital working in the same block.
4. Further, no additional financial implications are to be borne by EMRSs/ NESTS/ MoTA as these children shall not be a part of EMRS Scheme. Since no, fee is prescribed in EMRS scheme hence, the same shall not be charged from these students.

b. Reservation in Admission for Back log vacancies for 7th, 8th & 9th classes:

All the seats for backlog vacancies are reserved for ST students only.

C. Composition of Test for 6th class:

The EMRSST, conducted in offline mode, may be two -hour duration objective type question from 03 sections for a total of 100 marks. The medium of instructions for the examinations may be English / Regional language or bilingual.

The question paper of EMRSST will be based on competencies in accordance with the level prescribed for class V students by NCERT/SCERT/CBSE.

D. Composition of Test for 7th, 8th & 9th classes:

The entrance test for 7th, 8th & 9th classes will be conducted in offline mode and three hours duration shall be given for students to write both objective & descriptive type questions from 5 sections. The questions shall be asked from NCERT/ SCERT textbooks of preceding via Class VI-VIII in case of CBSE / State Board affiliated EMRSs respectively. There shall be total of 100 questions for 200 marks. The medium of instruction for the Examination is English / Regional language or bilingual.

The applications will be received through online from **27.03.2023** to **20.04.2023** on the website <https://fastses.telangana.gov.in/> by paying a Fee of **Rs. 100/-**.

2. Test Centers:

The identified EMRS schools in the districts will be the test centers and informed later .

OTHER IMPORTANT NOTE:

- The number of seats for boys and girls will be equal.
- The candidates belonging to the reservation categories mentioned at Reservation table are eligible to apply for EMRSST.
- Registration forms can be filled through online only.
- Even if EMRS is not available in the student's district, student can apply to study in the nearest EMRS. 30 percent of the seats in each EMRS are allotted to local district candidates on the basis of merit.

- The registration fee Rs.100 (One Hundred Only) to be paid by each and every candidate, who wants to apply for the selection Test.
- Mere payment of fee is not sufficient to submit the application form. After successful completion of online payment of fee Rs.100/-, every candidate has to completely fill in online application without fail.
- The incomplete application forms shall normally reject.
- It is compulsory that, the candidate selects the order of preference of school. So that allotment will be made accordingly as per merit and school option.
- Candidates are advised to take printout of acknowledgment form immediately after applying.
- Verification of proofs for residence, age, eligibility etc.. shall be done for selected candidates by the EMRS Principal concerned where the candidate has got the admission.
- Admission will be canceled by the principal of concerned EMRS at the time of admission/ at any time, if wrong certificates are submitted & no appeal against such action of the principal shall be considered.
- In case of any discrepancy, the decision of the Secretary, TSES is final.
